**Q1. Exploring Local Plants: A Nature Journal and Art Portfolio.**

- **Research Element:** Observe and identify at least ten different types of plants in your neighbourhood or a nearby green space. Research their names (both common and scientific, if possible), native origin, adaptations that help them survive in the local environment, and their role in the ecosystem (e.g., food source, shelter).
- **Art Integration:** Create a nature journal/scrap book with drawings of each plant, Include pressed specimens (leaves, flowers) and paste them in your scrap book. For each plant, write a short description combining your scientific observations with creative writing (e.g., a story from the plant's perspective, a poem about its beauty). Present your findings as an art portfolio/scrap book or a visually engaging journal.

**Q2. "Animal Architects: Habitats as Homes, Animal Feeding Mechanisms and Behaviours"**

- **Research Element:** Investigate how different animal species construct or utilize their habitats (e.g., nests, burrows, hives, dens). Research the specific adaptations that allow animals to thrive in their environments. Explore the concept of an ecosystem and how different habitats contribute to global biodiversity. Draw or paste pictures to support your observations.
- **Art Integration:** Design and build 3D models showcasing diverse animal habitats by using clay or surrounding natural materials. Each habitat should feature at least five animals and highlight the key adaptations that enable it to survive there. Include a written explanation of the animal's habitat, its adaptations, and its role in the ecosystem.
- Write the diverse ways animals obtain and consume food. Investigate habitats, behaviours, physiology different feeding structures (e.g., beaks, teeth, tongues), food choices or any other information Draw or paste their pictures in scrap book. Explore how these mechanisms are adapted to specific food sources and diets. Map out food chains and food webs, illustrating the flow of energy through different ecosystems.
- **Paste 5 pictures of herbivores, carnivores and omnivores in scrap book.**
- **Observe" Animal Parenting Strategies"**  
Write about Animal behaviour, parental care of animals, birds, insects you have observed in your surroundings (at least ten mammals, birds, reptiles, insects), paste their pictures and

investigate the diverse strategies animals use to care for their young, from simple egg-laying to complex nurturing behaviours. Compare and contrast different parenting styles across various animal groups (e.g., mammals, birds, reptiles, insects), paste their pictures of each in scrap book.

**Q3. Make a working model on any topic you like** after observing your immediate surroundings – be it your school, home, neighbourhood, or even the broader community – identify a recurring everyday problem or inefficiency that impacts people's lives. Formulate a specific question about this problem that you aim to answer through research and the development of a tangible solution. Your task is to then conduct authentic research to understand the problem's root causes and existing attempts at solutions. Based on your findings, design and build a functional prototype of your innovative solution. Finally, analyse the economic viability of your prototype and present a working model that demonstrates its practical application."

**OR**

**Design a board game** that educates players about a specific science/environmental science topic.

It should include:

1. A clear description of the game.
2. A detailed outline of the game rules, including how players can win.
3. A list of all the materials required to create the game (e.g., game board, cards, playing pieces).
4. Instructions on how the game can be visually engaging and interactive.
